

Hinton St George Primary School Pupil Premium 2021-22

The Pupil Premium is additional sums of money allocated to schools to support specific children:

- Those in receipt of free school meals (FSM)
- Ever 6- those who have had FSM in the last six years
- Children with a parent in the armed forces (Service children)
- Children post LAC

The way this is spent is the decision of the school, but it must be carefully targeted at achieving the best possible attainment and progress for the identified children.

Hinton St George has very few of these pupils. Therefore, it is important that we use this funding effectively to support these children within the school.

Pupil Premium 2021-22

Allocated funding for 2020-21 is £12,070

We aim to provide holistic support for our pupils in receipt of Pupil Premium funding to ensure they can develop to their educational, personal and social potential whilst at Hinton St George.

When making decisions on how best to spend this money, the Headteacher and Governors have considered the research available on the subject, most specifically that from the Sutton Trust (The Educational Endowment Trust). This indicates those strategies which might be used with children which give best results and best value for money.

Our funding this year has been allocated to support pupils in the following areas:

- Supply teacher costs to enable class teacher to provide booster group sessions.
- Learning support assistants to develop confidence and social skills through group nurture/ELSA sessions
- Travel costs for Educational Visits to widen their educational experience.
- Enrichment activities.
- Swimming lessons.
- Additional learning support assistants in the classroom to provide 1:1 educational, behaviour and emotional support.
