Our Christian Value this half term is Hope (Aspiration).

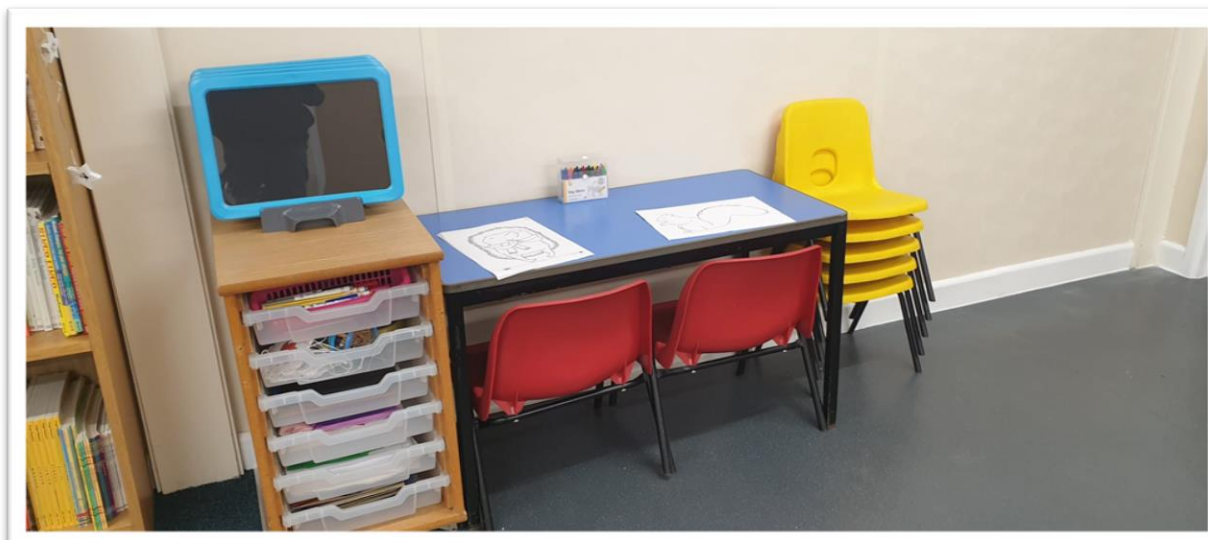
The children will explore this value in class and through worship.
