Safeguarding

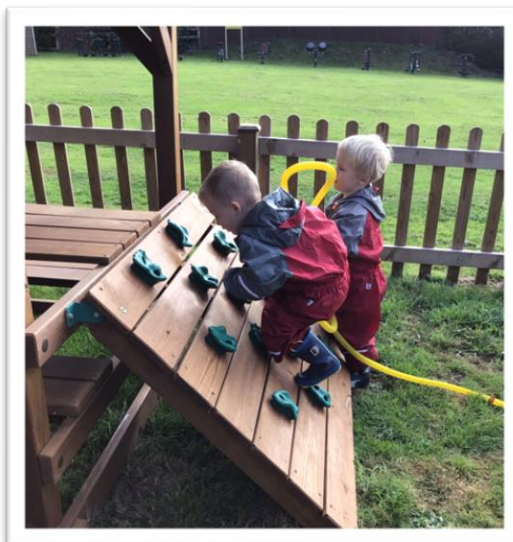
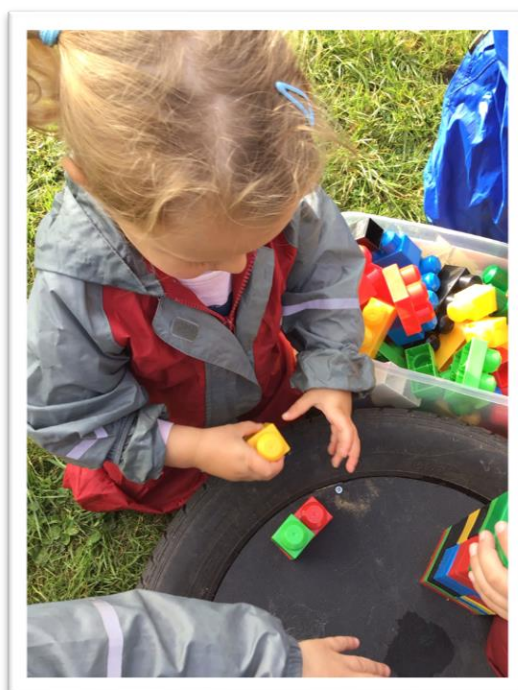
If you are worried about the safety of any child, then please speak to one of the following members of staff:
