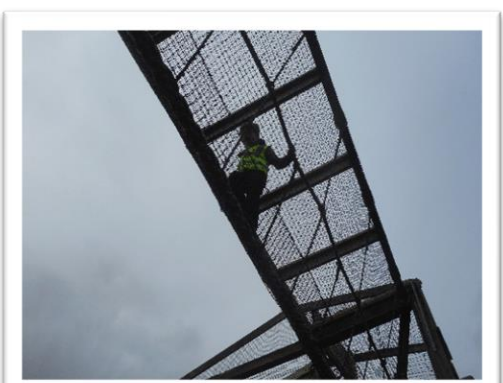
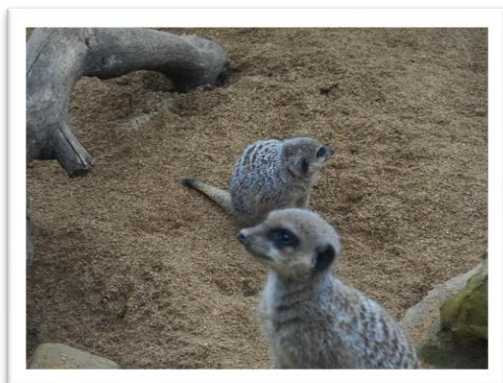
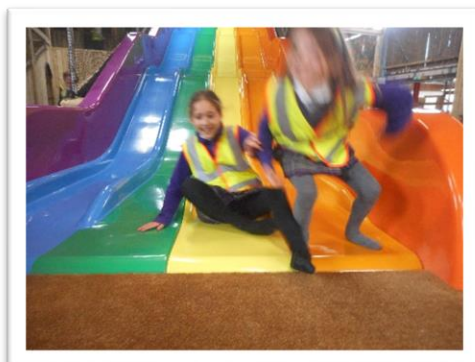
## **Safeguarding**
