Our Christian Value this half term is Perseverance. The children are continuing to explore this value in class and through daily worship.

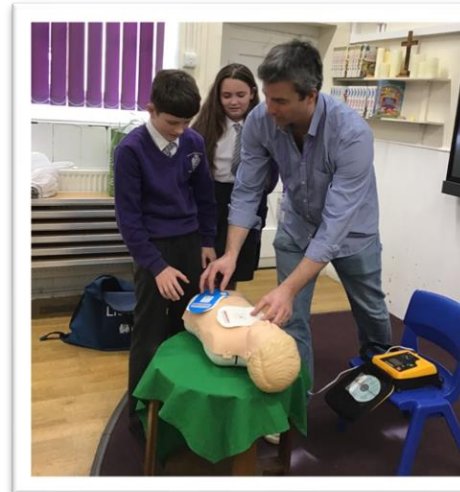
