Homework Menu

Please select **AT LEAST 1** activity from the following activities to do as your home learning this term. They will link in to our learning at school.

Reception:

- Draw, paint or collage a picture of some of the different people in your family.
- Speak to your family about what life was like when they were children. Maybe you could record yourself asking them questions (and you could email the recording to Mr. Batchelor)
- Think about your first few weeks at school, who has been a good friend to you in that time. Could you make a thankyou card for them to say thanks!
- Make a model of your house or your school.

Year 1 and 2:

- Maybe as a family you could visit Crewkerne Museum to find out what life might have been like in the 1950s. You could make a poster or a display of pictures that you took there, or write about some of the different things you learnt there.
- Do some research into the toys that your parents or grandparents used to play with. Can you draw a picture of them and write about what they do?
- Write a poem about what it is like to be a child.
- Draw or paint pictures of your favourite toys to make a toy gallery.
- Ask a relative about what it was like being a child when they were young, What was the same or different? Maybe you could record the interview and email it to Mr. Batchelor so he can share it with the other children. Make sure that you come up with a good list of questions to fins out lots of different things.
- Draw a picture of what you predict it will be like when you have children. What kind of toys will they play with in the future? What will they do for fun? What would school be like? Will there be robot teacher?
