- Look at any of the events which resulted in bringing an end or a change to the slave trade. Produce a news report (either written or spoken) describing the event.
- Choose a significant Black figure from the past or from modern day. They could be from sport, music, film, art, politics etc. Present them through art, a poem or a factfile.
- Look at any key events happening in Black History Month - October '24. Write a report about how it is being celebrated and what events are taking place.
- What changes would you like to see in our modern world? Write a letter to your MP expressing your views or record your own protest song.
- Sketch or paint your favourite African animals.
